
What means your name "The Cube Guys"? Why this choice?

Very important, but not fundamental. Regard studio, some guys still produce huge tracks with laptops only, because the main idea and



Do you have any hobbies outside music?


Different passions and hobbies... from technology to clothings, from expensive watches to wines, from cars to bicycles... sometimes is needed to fly away from music!
